

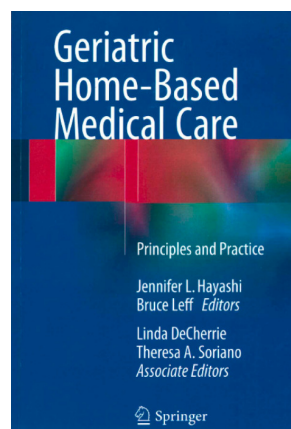

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## Home Centered Care Institute (HCCI)

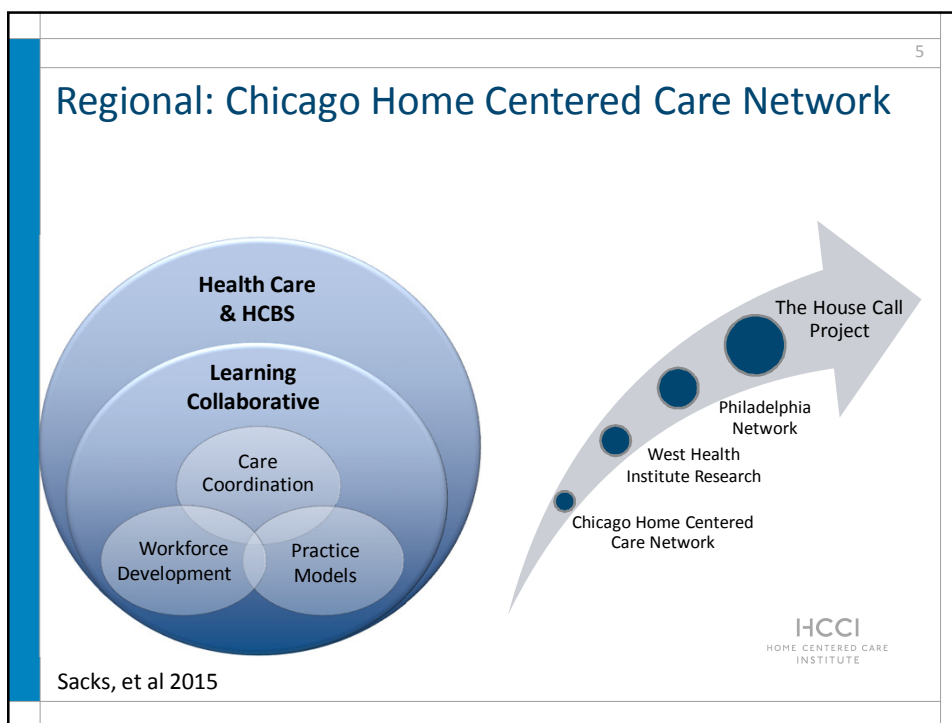
- **Home Centered Care Defined**
  - Interdisciplinary health and supportive services delivered to our nation’s most complex patients in their residence.
- **Mission**
  - To improve the accessibility and quality of care available to medically complex patients and their caregivers, and to reduce overall health care costs by advancing the practice of Home Centered Care.
- **Vision**
  - Quality house call programs, highly integrated with health care and support services, will be widespread and facilitate aging in place.

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## Home Centered Care Institute (HCCI)

- **Education**
  - Guiding health care delivery systems through the house call program development process and the shift to providing home-based primary care in a value-based model.
- **Innovation**
  - Developing and sharing tools and technology that improve the way coordinated care teams integrate, communicate, share data and improve care.
- **Research**
  - Bringing together leading experts in the clinical, policy and business sectors to test and improve the design and delivery of Home Centered Care.

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## The House Call Project



- **New Subsidiary of HCCI**
  - Focused on education and training to expand house call programs and home centered care
  - Collaborating with the American Academy of Home Care Medicine (AAHCM) and others to create clinical and practice management curriculum

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## Quality End-of-Life Care

- 2015 HomeCare Physicians: 230 deaths
  - 80% (184) died at home
  - 76% (175) where on hospice
  - Average length of stay 1.9 years; Median LOS 1.2 years
